2 September 2016	<b>TEAM REGISTRATION OPENS.</b>
12 September 2016	<b>ANTICIPATED RELEASE DATE</b> of the Compromis (The Jessup Problem).
3 October 2016	<b>ANTICIPATED RELEASE of First Batch of Basic Materials</b> on the ILSA website at <a href="http://www.ilsa.org/jessup">www.ilsa.org/jessup</a> .
14 October 2016	<b>DEADLINE for Requests from Teams for Corrections and Clarifications to the 2017 Jessup Compromis.</b> Requests must be submitted through the online form found under your Team's Home Page.
14 November 2016	<b>DEADLINE for Eligibility Inquiries.</b> This is the last day on which individuals may request the Executive Director's special permission to compete under Official Rule 2.4. <b>DEADLINE for Submission of Waiver Applications.</b> This is the last day on which teams with limited financial resources may apply for a waiver/discount of the registration fee.
18 November 2016	<b>DEADLINE for Team Registration</b> in the international rounds and in the Russian National Round (Online Forms and Payment). <b>DEADLINE for Submission of Team Roster.</b> This is the last day on which teams may submit the names of their team members. <b>ANTICIPATED RELEASE DATE</b> of Corrections and Clarifications to the Compromis.
21 November 2016	<b>DEADLINE for Second Batch Basic Materials Suggestions.</b> This is the last day on which teams may suggest documents to be included in the Second Batch of Basic Materials.
12 December 2016	<b>ANTICIPATED RELEASE of Second Batch of Basic Materials</b> on the ILSA website. The Second Batch of Materials is based upon requests from teams and usually includes a variety of treaties, case law, and secondary sources.
10 January 2017	<b>DEADLINE for Submission Memorials.</b> Teams must submit its Applicant and Respondent Memorials to the ILSA Executive Office via its Team Homepage (available through <a href="http://www.ilsa.org">http://www.ilsa.org</a> ), and send its Applicant and Respondent Memorials to the Administrator at <a href="mailto:jessup2017@threefold.ru">jessup2017@threefold.ru</a> no later than 10 January 2017, 11:59 pm Moscow time.
10–25 January 2017	Evaluation of Russian Memorials by Memorial Judges.
25 January 2017	<b>DISQUALIFICATION DEADLINE for Failure to Submit Memorials.</b> If a team fails to submit its Applicant and Respondent Memorials by this day, the Team will be disqualified from the Competition. Any Memorials submitted after the 10 January (Submission Deadline) but prior to the 25 January (Disqualification Deadline) will be subject to applicable late penalties.
1–5 February 2017	<b>2017 Russian National Championship.</b> Location – Lomonosov Moscow State University Law School The Final Round of the Russian Competition will take place at MGIMO Conference-hall.
